#### THE RULES OF CHESS

There are six different types of chess pieces: King, Queen, Rook, Bishop, Knight, and Pawn The chess set contains pieces of two different colors, one light and one dark, called White and Black The board is set up as shown [Ref: Figure 31] The white pieces begin on the 1st and 2nd ranks and the black pieces begin on the 7th and 8th ranks

Order of play Once all the pieces have been arranged, White makes the first move White always makes the first move; this is important for notation, and any chess player will insist upon it After White has made their move, Black will then make a move The gameplay will continue in alternating fashion, White making a move, followed by Black
